ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A24 GLA ROAD (CLAPHAM COMMON SOUTH SIDE, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable construction works to take place on the A24 Clapham Common South Side.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or exiting the unnamed access road to the former Southside Business Park at its junction with Clapham Common South Side.

Local Access will be maintained.

The Order will be effective from 8:00 AM on 17th September 2022 until 6:00 PM on 21st November 2022 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
