ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE TCS LONDON MARATHON (RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC IN CONNECTION WITH CERTAIN EVENTS) ORDER 2022

- I. Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A hereby gives notice that, after consulting the Commissioner of Police for the City of London, the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, the Royal Parks Foundation, the London Boroughs of Lambeth, Lewisham, Southwark, and Tower Hamlets, the Royal Borough of Greenwich, the City of Westminster and the Common Council of the City of London, the Commission for New Towns and Canary Wharf Management Limited, it has jointly made the above named Order in respect of our individual responsibility as traffic authority to facilitate the TCS London Marathon event, under the powers conferred by section 16A(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable the event known as "The TCS London Marathon" to take place.
- 3. The effect of the Order is to prohibit:
 - vehicles entering, exiting and proceeding in the carriageway
 of any street or length of street specified in Schedule 1 and
 2 to this Notice between the time specified in relation to
 each street or length of street (or earlier if required by a
 police constable in uniform) and a time when normal traffic
 operation can be resumed;
 - (2) stopping or waiting by vehicles (including waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) in each street and length of street specified in Schedule 1 and Schedule 3 to this Notice.
- 4. The Order will also:
 - suspend five gated road closures in the Royal Borough of Greenwich in Armitage Road, Azof Street, Mauritius Road, St German's Place and Old Woolwich Road between 7:00 AM and 3:00 PM on Sunday 2nd October 2022;
 - (2) suspend the gated road closure in the London Borough of Southwark on South Sea Street junction with Rope Street between 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM on Sunday 2nd October 2022;
 - (3) suspend the existing banned right turn for all vehicles except buses and cycles from Lower Road into Rotherhithe Old Road in the London Borough of Southwark between 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM on Sunday 2nd October 2022;
 - (4) suspend the banned left turn from Lowell Street into Commercial Road in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets between 8:00 AM and 7:00 PM on Sunday 2nd October 2022;
 - (5) suspend the bus only route on Blackwall Way west of its junction with Newport Avenue in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets between 8:00 AM and 7:00 PM on Sunday 2nd October 2022;

- (6) suspend width restrictions in the London Borough of Southwark on Quebec Way and in the Royal Borough of Greenwich on Charlton Park Lane and Tunnel Avenue between 7:00 AM and 4:00 PM on Sunday 2nd October 2022:
- (7) suspend the northern footway of Shooters Hill Road between Prince Charles Road and Vanbrugh Terrace between 8:00 AM Thursday 29th September 2022 and 6:00 AM Monday 3rd October 2022.
- The Order will also reverse or suspend the one-way traffic flow on:
 - Savoy Street in the City of Westminster allowing vehicles to travel in both directions between 7:30 AM and 11:30 AM on Saturday 1st October 2022 and between 7:30 AM and 8:30 PM on Sunday 2nd October 2022;
 - (2) Arundle Street and Surrey Street in the City of Westminster allowing vehicles to travel in both directions between 7:30 AM and 11:30 AM on Saturday 1st October 2022;
 - (3) Three Colt Street between Commercial Road and Newell Street in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets allowing vehicles to travel in both directions between 8:00 AM and 7:00 PM on Sunday 2nd October 2022.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of those provisions would hinder the use of the vehicle;
 - (2) any vehicle used in conjunction with The TCS London Marathon 2022 ("the Event");
 - (3) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London or any London Borough affected by this Order.
- Additional streets and lengths of streets may also be closed at the direction of a police constable in uniform, to facilitate alternative routes.
- 8. At such times as area activities prohibitions and suspensions are in force alternative routes will be indicated via traffic signs, advanced warning signs and VMS. Further information can be obtained via The TCS London Marathon 2022 website, press, regional press and radio coverage.
