ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A201 GLA ROAD (NEW KENT ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement and resurfacing works to take place on the A201 New Kent Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle except Taxis from stopping in the temporary taxi bay on the northern kerb of New Kent Road between a point 2 metres east of the extended eastern building line of No.28 New Kent Road to a point 10 metres eastwards. The bay will operate 'No stopping at any time, except taxis at authorised times'.
The Order will be effective at certain times from 7:00 AM on 19th September 2022 and 7:00 PM on 8th December 2022 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
