ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (THORNTON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable service pipes inspection and repair works to take place on the A23 Thornton Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on Thornton Road between its junction with Boston Road and the extended northern kerbline of Peall Road.

The Order will be effective between 7:00 AM on 11th October 2022 until 7:00 PM on 15th October 2022 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
