### Notice of Application for Variation of a Premises Licence

The application can also be viewed at the above address during office hours by appointment.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application. The maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction is £5,000.

Persons objecting to the grant of licences must be prepared to attend in person at a hearing before a committee of the Council.
