Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (St. Asaph Road, SE4)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in St. Asaph Road, SE4 between Aspinall Road (northern arm) and Avignon Road. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition shall be via St Asaph Road, Linden Grove, Nunhead Lane, Peckham Rye, Cheltenham Road, Ivydale Road, Brockley Way, St. Norbert Road, Friendsbury Road, Avignon Road and St. Asaph Road, and vice versa.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 3.** The order comes into force on the 1st November 2022 to remain in force for up to 3 months.
- 4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
