THE A3220 GLA ROAD (EDITH GROVE, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2022

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable new water connection works to take place at A3220 Edith Grove.
- Edith Grove between the extended northern building line of No. 2 Edith Grove and the extended common boundary of Nos. 13 and 15 Edith Grove.

 The Order will be effective between 11th November 2022 and 20th November 2022, every Friday at 8:00 AM until Sunday at 6:00 PM

(ceasing at 6:00 PM on 20th November 2022) or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only

3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping in

- during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:(1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire
 - brigade, ambulance or police purposes;(2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for
 - London.
