ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A217 GLA ROAD (RAM STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow mains water connection works to take place on Ram Street.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:

 (1) entering Ram Street at its junction with Wandsworth High Street;
 (2) stop in the Loading Bay outside The Post Office, No. 17 Ram Street.
 The Order will be effective between the dates of 29th October 2022 and 7th November 2022, every Saturday at 5:00 AM until Monday at 5:00 AM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to

time be indicated by traffic signs.

- any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
- constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
