## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

THE A202 GLA ROAD (WILTON ROAD) AND GLA SIDE ROADS, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

- I. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster
- hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable building development works to take place on the A202 Wilton Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
  - entering or proceeding on Wilton Road between its junctions with Gillingham Street and Bridge Place;
     entering or proceeding on Bridge Place between its junction with
  - Wilton Road and the access road to Double Tree Hotel car park;
    (3) stopping on Bridge Place between its junctions with Wilton Road and
  - Belgrave Road; This Order will also:
  - (4) permit two-way operation on Bridge Place between its junction with Belgrave Road and the access road to Double Tree Hotel car park.
  - (5) suspend the banned right turn from Belgrave Road into Bridge Place; (6) suspend the pedestrian crossing on Bridge Place at its junction with
    - Wilton Road;

      (7) suspend the southern footway of Bridge Place between its junction
    - with Wilton Road and the access road to Double Tree Hotel car park. Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.
  - The Order will be effective at certain times from 7:00 AM on 14th November 2022 until 7:00 PM on 1st May 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. For Bridge Place closure via Northbound via Wilton Road southbound, Gillingham Street and Belgrave Walk to normal route of travel. For Wilton Road closure via Gillingham Street eastbound, Vauxhall Bridge Road and Neathouse Place to normal route of travel.
