1 NOTICE IS HERERY GIVEN that to enable detailed bridge inspection works to be carried out to the railway bridge over Atlantic Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect

of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Atlantic Road between Brixton Road and Electric Avenue, whenever indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be

available via (i) Coldharbour Lane, Effra Road, St Matthew's Road, Brixton Hill and Brixton Road; and (ii) Brixton Road, Effra Road, St Matthew's Road, Brixton Hill and

Coldharbour Lane.

The Order would come into force on 14th November 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order

would only have effect between 11 pm and 4 am on 14th and 15th November 2022, but if the works cannot be
