

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE AND TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS LAMBETH ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable development related works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:

- (a) ban pedestrians from entering that section of the north-western footway in Lambeth Road, between the western kerb-line of Hercules Road and a point 3 metres southwest of the north-eastern boundary of No. 214 Lambeth Road;
- (b) suspend the north-eastbound bus lane on Lambeth Road, between a point 3 metres south-west of the north-eastern boundary of No. 214 Lambeth Road and the western kerb-line of Hercules Road;
- (c) suspend the south-westbound bus lane on Lambeth Road, between the northwestern kerb-line of Sail Street and the north-eastern kerb-line of Pratt Walk; and
- (d) ban vehicles travelling in the south-east to north-west link road between Sail Street and Lambeth Road from turning right onto Lambeth Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles and pedestrians will be provided:

- (a) for 1(a) above via the south-eastern footway of Lambeth Road; and
- (b) for 1(d) above via Lambeth Road and Lambeth Bridge Roundabout.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 14th November 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier.
