Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Jerningham Road, SE14 & St. John's Vale, SE8) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the Order are indicated below.

1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Jerningham Road, SE14 between the A2 New Cross Road and the rearmost building line of No.254 New Cross Road in any other than a northerly direction; and (ii) John's Vale, SE8 between Albyn Road and Cliff Terrace. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via (i) A2 New Cross Road, Musgrove Road and Troutbeck Road; and (ii) Albyn Road, Friendly Street, Lewisham Way and St. John's Vale, and vice versa.

2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

3. The order comes into force on the 20th January 2023 to remain in force for up to 2 months.

(Note: Works are expected to be completed overnight on the 20th January 2023.)

4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
