1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Paragon Place. SE3.

- between the projected northern boundary of No.32 Paragon Place and the projected northern bendary of No.32 Paragon Place and the projected northern kerbline of Lynch Close. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition shall be via (i) Paragon Place, Montpelier Row, Wemyss Road and paragon Place; and (ii) Paragon Place, Wemyss Road, Montpelier Row, Montpelier Vale, Tranquil Vale, Royal Parade, Montpelier Row and Paragon place.
- Exemption will be provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

 The order is intended to come into force on the 9th January 2023
 - to remain in force for up to 2 months.
 (Note: Works are expected to be complete by 13th January 2023.)
- 4. The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
