The Lewisham (Various Roads)

(Thames Water Lead Replacement Project)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.6) Order 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in the roads shown below.
(i) Avignon Road; 16th March to 13th April 2023; (ii) Bell Green Lane; 24th March to 5th April 2023; (iii) Burford Road; 19th January to 28th February 2023; (iv) Elvino Road; 28th February to 10th March 2023; (v) Holdenby Road; 22nd February to 22nd March 2023; (vi) Ravensbourne Park Crescent; 9th Dec 2022 to 25th Jan 2023; (vii) Rockbourne Road; 20th February to 16th March 2023; (2) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibitions are via local neighbouring roads and will be as signed on the ground.

2. No parking/waiting in the roads shown below.

(i) Exbury Road; 18th November to 15th December 2022; (ii) Kangley Bridge Rd; 10th March to 7th Apr 2023;

(Note: Dates shown in articles 1 and 2 above are liable to change. Thames Water will distribute information about the proposed start date and likely duration to each property in each road prior to starting works.)

3. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

4. The order comes into force on the 14th November 2022 to remain in force for 6 months or until the works are complete, whichever is the sooner.

5. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
