ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (DRUID STREET/ CRUCIFIX LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

- 1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable rail bridge inspection works to take place on the A200 Druid Street/ Crucifix Lane.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from: (I) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Druid Street/Crucifix Lane between its junctions with White's Grounds and Bermondsey Street:
 - (2) entering or proceeding along Barnham Street between its junctions with Tooley Street and Crucifix Lane, local access to be maintained between Tooley Street and No.41 Barnham Street;
 - (3) entering or proceeding along Shand Street between its junctions with Holyrood Street and Crucifix Lane;
 - (4) exiting Whites Grounds at its junction with Druid Street;

The Order will also permit two-way operation on:

(5) Shand Street between its junctions with Holyrood Street and Tooley Street.

The Order will be effective between 28 th November and 30 th November 2022 each night from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time

- to time be indicated by traffic signs. 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: Whites Grounds & Bermondsey Street to normal route of travel. For HGV via Tower Bridge Road, Bermondsey Street, Long Lane & Borough High Street to normal route of travel. For Barnham Street and Shand Street via: Tooley Street, Tanner Street, Druid Street, Whites Grounds & Dermondsey Street to normal route of travel.
