ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (DRUID STREET/ CRUCIFIX LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable rail bridge inspection works to take place on the A200 Druid Street/ Crucifix Lane.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Druid Street/Crucifix Lane between its junctions with White's Grounds and Bermondsey Street;
 - (2) entering or proceeding along Barnham Street between its junctions with Tooley Street and Crucifix Lane, local access to be maintained between Tooley Street and No.41 Barnham Street;
 - (3) entering or proceeding along Shand Street between its junctions with Holyrood Street and Crucifix Lane;
 - (4) exiting Whites Grounds at its junction with Druid Street;The Order will also permit two-way operation on:
 - (5) Shand Street between its junctions with Holyrood Street and Tooley Street.

The Order will be effective between 28 th November and 30 th November 2022 each night from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: Whites Grounds & Bermondsey Street to normal route of travel. For HGV via Tower Bridge Road, Bermondsey Street, Long Lane & Borough High Street to normal route of travel. For Barnham Street and Shand Street via: Tooley Street, Tanner Street, Druid Street, Whites Grounds & Bermondsey Street to normal route of travel.
