ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (PURLEY WAY, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

- I. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Croydon hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2.The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement and resurfacing works to take place on the A23 Purley Way.3.The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - entering, exiting or proceeding in a southerly direction on Purley Way between its junctions with Lombard Roundabout and Beddington Farm Road, local access will be maintained between Lombard Roundabout and Miller Road:
 - (2) entering or proceeding in a southerly direction on Ampere Way between its junction with Faraday Way and Purley Way southbound;
 - (3) entering or proceeding in a westerly direction on Miller Road between its junctions with Thomson Crescent and Purley Way, local access will be maintained between Thomson Road and Euston Road;
 - (4) entering or proceeding in a southerly direction on Thomson Crescent between its junctions with Euston Road and Miller Road, local access will be maintained.
 - Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.
 - The Order will be effective at certain times between 14th November 2022 and 14th May 2023, every night 9:00 PM until 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London
- constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London. 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be
- indicated by traffic signs via Lombard Roundabout, Mitcham Road, Roman Way, Old Town, Davenant Road, Duppas Hill Road and Stafford Road to normal route of travel.
