ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A24 GLA ROADS (TOOTING HIGH STREET & UPPER TOOTING ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable ground penetrating radar survey works to take place on the A24 Tooting High Street and A24 Upper
- Tooting Road. 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (I) Entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Carlwell Street between the extended common boundary of No. 2 Carlwell Street and of No. 196 Tooting High Street and its junction with A24 Tooting High
 - (2) Entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Trevelyan Road at its
 - junction with A24 Tooting High Street (3) Entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Cowick Road between its junctions with Ruislip Street and with A24 Upper Tooting Road;
 - the extended western building line of Tesco, No.130, Upper Tooting Road, and its junction with A24 Upper Tooting Road. Access to the Tesco car park will be maintained; (5) Entering or exiting Lessingham Avenue at its junction with A24

(4) Entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Ansell Road between

- Upper Tooting Road; (6) stopping in the Loading Bay on Lessingham Avenue at the side of
- No. 147 Upper Tooting Road; (7) stopping in the Parking Bay on Lessingham Avenue at the side of
- Nos. 127 145 Upper Tooting Road; The Order will be effective at certain times from the 14th November 2022 until the 22nd December 2022, every night from 10:00 Pm to 5:00
- AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via [For Trevelyan Road] Tooting High Street, Sellincourt Road, Mellison Road to normal route of travel. [For Carlwell Street] Tooting High Street, Blackshaw Road, Maybury Street to normal route of travel OR Tooting High Street, Aldis Street, Maybury Street to normal route of travel. [For Lessingham Avenue] Upper Tooting Road, Cowick Road, Blakenham Road to normal route of travel OR Upper Tooting Road, Lynwood Road, Blakenham Road to normal route of travel. [For Ansell Road] Upper Tooting Road, Hebdon Road,

Fishponds Road to normal route of travel. [For Cowick Road] Upper

Tooting Road, Lessingham Avenue, Ruislips Street to normal route of travel. Dated this 11th day of November 2022
