- (a) ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) in that length of Aberfovle Road which lies between Carnforth Road and the party wall of Nos.
 - 48 and 50 Aberfovle Road: (b) ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) in that length of Carnforth Road which lies between Aberfovle Road and the south-western property boundary of No. 27 Carnforth Road:
 - (c) suspend the Order imposing a one-way system in that length of Aberfoyle which lies between Broadview Road and the party wall of Nos. 48 and 50 Aberfovle Road: and (d) suspend the Order imposing a one-way system in that length of Carnforth Road which lies between
 - Broadview Road and the north-eastern property boundary of No. 27 Carnforth Road.
- 2. The alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Abercairn Boad Broadview Boad and Carnforth Road and vice versa 3. The bans and suspension of one-ways will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. 4. The Order will come into force on 9th January 2023 for

a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 3 days. but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at subsequent
