TEMPORARY WAITING AND LOADING

RESTRICTIONS ELLORA ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily ban any vehicle from waiting, including waiting for the purposes of loading / unloading, in Ellora Road, both sides, between the common boundary of Nos. 3 and 5 Ellora Road and the common boundary of Nos. 13 and 15 Ellora Road.
2. The north-eastern footway of Ellora Road, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 5 and 7 Ellora Road and the common boundary of Nos. 11 and 13 Ellora Road, will be closed to pedestrians.
3. Alternative routes for affected pedestrians will be provided via the south-western footway of Ellora Road.
4. The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
5. The Order will come into force on 12th December 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works will take place between 12th December 2022 and 16th December 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order will also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
