The Lewisham (Various Roads)

(Thames Water Lead Replacement Project)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.7) Order 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Broseley Grove (15th March to 7th April); (ii) Faversham Road (9th March to 7th April); (iii) Gabriel Street (9th February to 15th March); and (iv) St Asaph Road (3rd January to 26th April). (2) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibitions are via local neighbouring roads and will be as signed on the ground. (Note: Dates shown above are liable to change. Thames Water will distribute information about the proposed start date and likely duration to properties in each road prior to starting works.)

2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

3. The order comes into force on the 3rd January 2023 to remain in force for 6 months or until the works are complete, whichever is the sooner.

4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
