THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3212 GLA ROAD (CHEYNE WALK, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) PRESCRIBED ROUTE TRAFFIC ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that on 9th December 2022 it made the above named Order, under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into force on 19th December 2022.
2. The general nature and effect of the Order would be to make all vehicles proceeding south-westwards in lane 2 and lane 3 of A3212 Cheyne Walk proceed straight ahead at its junction with Beaufort Street.
3. The road which would be affected by the Order is A3212 Cheyne Walk in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.
4.
