ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3 GLA ROAD (KENNINGTON PARK ROAD, LONDON BOROUGHS OF LAMBETH AND SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY **BANNED TURNS) ORDER 2022**

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water meter installation works to take place at A3 Kennington Park Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering Kennington Park Place at its junction with Kennington Park Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 8:00 AM on 4th January 2023 until 10:00 PM on 12th January 2023 or when the works

- have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: Braganza Street, De Laune Street and Kennington Park Place to normal route of travel: Kennington Park Road. Brixton Road, Camberwell New Road, John Ruskin Street, Dale Road and Cooks Road to normal route of travel.
