

Transport for London Notice

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (LONDON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) (NO.2) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it had made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable bridge inspection works to take place at A23 London Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) stopping on the A23 London Road between its junction with Roche Road and Acacia Road (both directions);
 - (2) stopping in the Loading/ Unloading and Disabled Persons' Vehicles Bay on Norbury Avenue close to its junction with the A23 London Road;
 - (3) stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons' Vehicles Bay on Norbury Avenue, close to its junction with the A23 London Road.The footways on London Road between its junctions with Roche Road and Acacia Road, (in both directions), will be closed during the works. The Order will be effective between 12th December 2022 and 15th December 2022 on the following days: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday every night from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
