## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

THE A201 GLA ROAD (NEW KENT ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

- 1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement works to take place on the A201 New Kent Road. 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:

(I) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on New Kent Road

- between its junctions with Newington Causeway and Bricklayer's Arms Roundabout: (2) entering or proceeding on the A2 off-slip road between its junctions
- with Old Kent Road and New Kent Road westbound: This Order will also:
- (3) permit two-way operation on Balfour Street between its junctions
- with Munton Road and New Kent Road;
- (4) permit two-way operation on Rodney Place between its junctions with Munton Road and New Kent Road:
- (5) permit two-way operation on Elephant Road between its junctions with Walworth Road and New Kent Road:
- (6) permit two-way operation on Harper Road between its junctions with County Street and New Kent Road. The Order will be effective at certain times between 14th January 2023
- and 19th July 2023, every day 9:00 AM until 5:00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to
- time be indicated by traffic signs. 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for
- London. 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Newington Causeway, Borough High Street, Great Dover Street and Bricklayer's Arms Roundabout or reverse to normal route of travel.
