ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS - BERNAY'S GROVE AND BRIGHTON TERRACE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable SGN to carry out gas main disconnection works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-

- (a) impose a one-way system in that length of Brighton Terrace which lies between Brixton Road and Bernay's Grove in westerly direction (towards Bernay's Grove);
- (b) ban all vehicles proceeding in Bernay's Grove from turning left into Brighton Terrace.

2. An alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via Brighton Terrace, Trinity Gardens, Acre Lane and Brixton Road.

3. The Order would come into force on 21st January 2023 and continue for 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
