

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS -
GLENELDON MEWS**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water to carry out repair and maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Gleneldon Mews, which lies between Stanthorpe Road and No. 13 Gleneldon Mews.

2. Alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via (a) Gleneldon Road, Bournevale Road and Stanthorpe Road; (b) Stanthorpe Road, Streatham High Road, Streatham Common North, Valley Road, Wellfield Road, Sunnyhill Road, Streatham High Road and Gleneldon Road.

3. The above temporary traffic restrictions would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 24th January 2023, and it would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
