- (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting on (i) Stanstead Road, between Rockbourne Road and Rojack Road; (ii) Beadnell Road, between Stanstead Road and the projected common boundary of Nos. 3 & 5 Beadnell Road; and (iii) Rojack Road. (2) There are no diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibition above. (Note: Access for residents will be maintained as far as practicable during the works.)
- Exemption will be provided in the order for vehicles engaged on
 the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police
 purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction
 of a police officer.
 The order is intended to come into force on the 6th February 2023
- to remain in force for up to 6 months. (Note: Works are planned to be carried out in phases to ensure not all the roads are closed simultaneously.)

 A. The prohibitions will enable so when and to the extent signed.
- The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
