ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A102 GLA ROAD (BLACKWALL TUNNEL SOUTHERN APPROACH, ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement and resurfacing works to take place on the A102 Blackwall Tunnel Southern Approach.

3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or

- proceeding in a northerly direction on Blackwall Tunnel Southern Approach between the A102 off-slip road to Woolwich Road and the A102 on-slip road from Woolwich Road.

 The Order will be effective at certain times between 2nd February 2023 and 2nd August 2023, every night 9:00 PM until 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire
 - brigade, ambulance or police purposes;(2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London

5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be

indicated by traffic signs via the A102 off-slip road to Woolwich Road, Woolwich Road and the A102 on-slip road from Woolwich Road to normal route of travel.
