

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ALBERT**  
**EMBANKMENT AND SALAMANCA STREET**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable development related works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:

- (a) ban vehicles from entering that section of the service road fronting Nos. 9 to 20 Albert Embankment which lies between a point 4 metres south of the northern boundary of Nos. 10 to 11 Albert Embankment and a point 12 metres north-east of the eastern kerb-line of Albert Embankment;
- (b) ban vehicles from entering that section of Salamanca Street, which lies between the eastern kerb-line of Albert Embankment and the western kerb-line of the driveway entrance adjacent to the back of No. 18 Albert Embankment; and
- (c) ban pedestrians from entering that section of the south-western footway, which lies between the eastern kerb-line of Albert Embankment and the western kerb-line of the driveway entrance adjacent to the back of No. 18 Albert Embankment.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Tinworth Street, Vauxhall Walk, Black Prince Road, Salamanca Street and Albert Embankment.

3. Alternative routes for affected pedestrians would be provided via the north-eastern footway of Salamanca Street.

4. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

5. The Order would come into force on 20th February 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier.
