VEHICLES – ROLT STREET

The Lewisham (Prescribed Routes) (No. 13) Traffic Order 2023

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council on 15th February 2023 made the above-mentioned Order under the powers of sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to continue indefinitely the provisions of The Lewisham (Prescribed Routes) (No. 5) Experimental Traffic Order 2021 which prohibits all motor vehicles from entering into or proceeding on Rolt Street, between a point 10 metres west of the south-western wall of No. 111 Rolt Street and 10 metres east of the south-eastern wall of No. 222a Trundley's Road, as part of a scheme of liveable neighbourhoods highway works, adjacent to parks and open spaces in the Deptford area.
3. Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the office of Lewisham Transport Policy & Development, 5th Floor Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London SE6 4RU.
4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
