

LICENSING ACT 2003

Application for Variation of Premises Licence

Mr Bayram Teber has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth to vary a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises: Bayka Food Centre, 278 Norwood Road, London, SE27 9AJ:

The nature of the variation is as follows:

To remove SIA conditions 16 and 17 from the current premises licence, the premises is such a small business with a low volume of customers between 21:00 and closing times that it would not require a member of SIA staff to be employed. To add one additional condition.

The record of this application may be inspected during normal office hours by an appointment at the Licensing Section, London Borough of Lambeth, 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London, SW2 1EG, or via the licensing authority's website, at www.lambeth.gov.uk/licensing

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to licensing@lambeth.gov.uk and must be received no later than 21/04/2023.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
