works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of

the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Eastlake Road which lies between No. 10 Eastlake Road and No. 18 Eastlake Road.

 Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via: Flaxman Road, Luxor Street and Coldharbour Lane, and vice versa.
 The ban would only apply at such times and to such

extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 10th April 2023 for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed,

a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 10th April 2023 and 11th May 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 3 months.
