and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 6) Order 2023 and the Lambeth (Free Parking Places) (Bicycle Parking Hangars) (No. 1) Order 2023 under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Orders will come

(a) ban motor vehicles from entering that part of Dorset Road which lies between a point 5 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Clapham Road and a

(b) ban motor vehicles from entering that part of Fentiman Road which lies between the south-eastern kerbline of Palfrey Road and the north-western kerb-line of Clapham

(c) ban waiting by vehicles at any time (indicated on the carriageway by double yellow lines) in the lengths of road described in Schedule 1 to this Notice; (d) remove the double yellow lines in the lengths of road described in Schedule 2 to
