ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - ST MATTHEW'S ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable resurfacing and landscaping works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of St Matthew's Road which lies between Hicken Road and the southern kerb-line of the car park which lies adjacent to the northernmost boundary wall of Camsey House, St Matthew's Estate, St Matthew's Road.

2. The above road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. Alternative routes for motor vehicles will not be available as this length of St Matthew's Road is closed to motor vehicles at its junction with Hicken Road.

4. The Order will come into force on 13th March 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will have effect from 13th March until 14th April 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 2 months.
