ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES AND TEMPORARY WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS THORNLA W ROAD & THURLBY ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water supply disconnection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:

(a) in Thornlaw Road:

- (i) ban vehicles from entering that section which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 73 and 75 Thornlaw Road and the common boundary of Nos. 93 and 95 Thornlaw Road; and
- (ii) ban any vehicle from waiting, including waiting for the purposes of loading / unloading, in that section of Thornlaw Road, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 69 and 71 Thornlaw Road and the common boundary of Nos. 95 and 97 Thornlaw Road;

(b) in Thurlby Road:

- (i) ban vehicles from entering that section which lies between the north-western kerb-line of Thornlaw Road and the north-western building wall of No. 89 Thurlby Road; and
- (ii) ban any vehicle from waiting, including waiting for the purposes of loading / unloading, in that section of Thurlby Road, which lies between the north-western kerb-line of Thornlaw Road and the north-western building wall of No. 89 Thurlby Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be provided via Casewick Road, St Julian's Farm Road, Lamberhurst Road and vice versa.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 27th March 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works will take place between 27th March 2023 and 31st July 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order will also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
