4. The Order will come into force on 10th April 2023 for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order will have effect from 10th April for 12 days, but if the works cannot

be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
