Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham (Various Roads) (Telecoms Works) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

 (1) Westbound road closure and no parking/waiting in Ladywell Road, SE13 between Lewisham High Street and the projected western boundary of 384 Lewisham High Street. (2) The diversion route for traffic affected by the prohibition is via (i) A21 southbound, A205 westbound, Brockley Rise, Stondon Park, Brockley Road and Adelaide Avenue; and (ii) A21 northbound, A20 westbound, Malpas Road, Brockley Cross, Brockley Road and Adelaide Avenue.

 (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Jerningham Road, SE14 between the A2 New Cross Road and the rearmost building line of No.254 New Cross Road in any other than a northerly direction; (2) The alternative route for traffic affected by the prohibition is via (i) A2 New Cross Road, Musgrove Rod and Troutbeck Road.

 Road closure and no parking/waiting in John's Vale, SE8 between Albyn Road and Cliff Terrace. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via Albyn Road, Friendly Street, Lewisham Way and SJ. John's Vale, and vice versa.

 Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

 The order comes into force on the 20th March 2023 to remain in force for up to 2 months. (Note: Works are planned to be carried out over 1 night on 20th March 2023).

6. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
