ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A40 GLA ROAD (MARBLE ARCH, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2023

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable development works to take place on the A40 Marble Arch.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
- (1) turning left from Marble Arch eastbound into Great Cumberland

The Order will also:

Place northbound:

(2) suspend the northern footway of Marble Arch between its junctions with Edgware Road and Great Cumberland Place.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at

certain times. The Order will be effective at certain times between 20th March 2023 and 7th April 2023, every Monday to Friday 8:00 AM until 6:00 PM and Saturday and Sunday 12:01 PM until 6:00 PM or when the works have

been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Oxford Street, Portman Street and Seymour Street to normal route of travel.
