ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (ST THOMAS STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2023

- 1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable footway and kerb improvement works to take place on the A200 St Thomas Street. 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on
- St Thomas Street between Nos.13 and 15 St Thomas Street and the vehicular access to The Shard. St Thomas Street. The Order will be effective at certain times from 7:00 AM on the 15th April 2023 until 7:00 PM on the 28th July 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
