ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - SALAMANCA STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Salamanca Street, which lies between the south-eastern kerb-line of the service road fronting Nos. 9 to 23 Albert Embankment and Salamanca Place.

2. Alternative routes will be available for affected vehicles via (a) Vauxhall Walk, Tinworth Street and Albert Embankment; and (b) Albert Embankment, Black Prince Road and Vauxhall Walk.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 1st May 2023 for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order will be in force between 1st May 2023 and 28th July 2023 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may also have effect on subsequent days and times within the maximum period of 6 months.
