- above named Order under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The general nature and effect of the Order would be to impose a speed limit of 20 MPH speed limit on all GLA Roads and GLA Side Road extents in the London Borough of Lambeth. The Order will also impose a 20 MPH speed limit on a small section of Nine Elms Lane and Wandsworth Road in the London Borough of Wandsworth.
- Clapham High Street, A23 Brixton Hill/Brixton Road, A203 Stockwell Road, A3200 Stamford Street/ York Road, A3036 Lambeth Palace Road/ Albert Embankment, Lambeth Bridge, Vauxhall Bridge and Westminster Bridge.

`The Order will also consolidate existing 20 MPH schemes on A3

- 3. The roads which would be affected by the Order are GLA Main Roads and all GLA Side Roads - Red Route returns of these roads in the London Borough of Lambeth as listed in article 2 above.
- 4. The roads affected are currently subject to a permanent speed limit of 30 MPH.
