THE A205 GLA ROAD AND GLA SIDE ROADS (ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2023

- Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Order under sections 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The general nature and effect of the Order would be to impose a speed limit of:
 - (1) 20 MPH speed limit on the A205 John Wilson Street, Grand Depot Road, Woolwich New Road, Woolwich Common, Academy Road and Well Hall Road and all GLA Side Roads Red Route returns of these roads in the Royal Borough of Greenwich;
 - (2) 30 MPH speed limit on the A205 Westhorne Avenue between Yorkshire Grey Roundabout and No.491 Westhorne Avenue.
- 3. The roads which would be affected by the Order are GLA Main Roads and all GLA Side Roads Red Route returns of these roads in the Royal Borough of Greenwich as listed in article 2 above.
- 4. The roads affected are currently subject to a permanent speed limit of 30 MPH and 40 MPH.
