ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3214 GLA ROAD (BUCKINGHAM PALACE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable a crane operation works to take place on the A3214 Buckingham Palace Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
- Road between Victoria Street and Elizabeth Bridge, except local buses between Victoria Street and Terminus Place;

 (2) entering or proceeding in a southerly direction on Buckingham Palace

(I) entering or proceeding in a southerly direction on Buckingham Palace

(2) entering or proceeding in a southerly direction on Buckingham Palace Road between Bressenden Place and Victoria Street, local access will be maintained;

(3) stopping in the Loading bay outside No.111 Buckingham Palace Road.

- The Order will be effective between 29th April 2023 and 2nd July 2023, every Saturday at 5:00 AM until Sunday at 11:59 PM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Bressenden Place, Victoria Street, Grosvenor Gardens, Hobart Place, Eaton Square, Eaton Gate, Cliveden Place, Sloane Square, Lower Sloane Street and Pimlico Road to normal route of travel.
