

Transport for London Notice

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A501 GLA SIDE ROAD (KNOX STREET, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gas connection works to take place on the A501 GLA Side Road – Knox Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering or proceeding on Knox Street between its junctions with York Street and Marylebone Road, local access will be maintained between York Street and Nos. 31 and 32 Knox Street;
 - (2) stopping on Knox Street between its junctions with Marylebone Road and Nos. 31 and 32 Knox Street;

The Order will also:

- (3) permit two-way operation on Knox Street between its junction with York Street and Nos. 31 and 32 Knox Street.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 7:00 AM on the 15th May 2023 until 7:00 PM on the 15th June 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via York Street and Upper Montagu Street to normal route of travel.
