Travel, Subsistence & Other Expenses: certain expenses can be claimed for eligible duties; full details are set out in Part 5 of the Council's Constitution. Civic expenses: A civic expenses budget of £2,000 is available to meet the costs of

civic gifts and hospitality and maintenance of civic regalia.
