

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS –**  
**GRACEFIELD GARDENS**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Gracefield Gardens which lies between the south-western kerb-line of the service road at the rear of Nos. 1 to 10 Ascot Parade, Streatham High Road and Woodleigh Gardens.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via: (a) Woodleigh Gardens, Leigham Avenue and Streatham High Road and vice versa; and (b) Streatham High Road, Pendennis Road and Newcombe Gardens and vice versa.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 14th May 2023 for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will be carried out on 14th May 2023 with a backup date of 21st May 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates then the Order may also have effect on subsequent days within the maximum period of 1 month.
