The new hours of operation would be between 8.30 am and 9.30 am and 3 pm and 4 pm on Mondays to Fridays, during school term-time; (b) Burgoyne Road, the current zone operates between

8.15 am and 9.15 am and 2.45 pm and 3.45 pm on Mondays to Fridays, during school term-time. The new hours of operation would be between 8.30 am and 9.30 am and 3 pm and 4 pm on Mondays to Fridays, during school term-time;

(c) Lowden Road, the current zone operates between 8 am and 9 am and between 3 pm and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays, during school term-time. The new hours of operation would be between 8.15 am and 9.15 am and 3 pm and 4 pm on Mondays to
