of Nos. 12 and 13 Pyrmont Grove and a point 15 metres south of that point; and Martell Road, the south-west side between a point opposite the south-eastern (xi) boundary of No. 10 Park Hall Road and a point 20 metres south-east of that point. 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will not be required.

3. The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. 4. The Order will come into force on 9th May 2023 and will continue for a maximum

duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works will take place between the 9th May 2023 and the 12th May 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order will also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
