ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE TRELAWN ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable telecommunication ducting work to be carried out by BT on Effra Road and Trelawn Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Trelawn Road which lies between Effra Road and a point 12 metres north-east of Effra Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via: (a) Effra Road and Morval Road; and (b) Morval Road, Dalberg Road, Brixton Water Lane and Effra Road.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 17th May 2023 for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 17th May and 19th May 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
